CLUB RULES

All entries and admissions are at the committee's discretion.

Neither BDRC nor the landowner accepts any responsibility for loss or damage to any horse, vehicle, persons, or any other property, arising from any show.

Most classes run a points championship. Points will be awarded on a 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 basis for the first 6 places and will be decided over all the club shows. Points will count with the same combination only.

Back protectors are strongly recommended for jumping classes. They are compulsory for cross-country. The committee reserves the right to cancel, change, or adjust, any of the classes at any of its meetings, without giving notice.

Correct attire must be worn in all events. Long sleeves are required in all jumping rings and for cross country events.

Hard hats to the latest standard (PAS015) must be worn and fastened when mounted.

Hard hats must also be worn by all competitors under 14yrs old in all in-hand classes.

Suitable small heeled footwear must also be worn.

Outside assistance to competitors in any competition will result in the competitor being eliminated. (This does not apply to the first two jumping classes or the clear round ring).

Lean rein entries must be led at all times over all fences, non-lead rein entries must not be led at any time.

It is the competitor's responsibility to present themselves at the correct ring at the correct time.

No horse/pony can be entered competitively more than once in each class.

All mountain and moorland classes must be shown natural. Part-breeds may be shown plaited.

Entire males over the age of 1yrs old must be bitted and control at all times. They must not be shown by children under the age of 14 years old.

No horse or pony under 4yrs of age to be jumped anywhere on the show field.

The use of foul and abusive language will not be tolerated.

No trotting or cantering in spectator or parking areas.

In jumping classes, fence heights are approximate.

Competitors must enter & leave the ring at walk.

In all classes, ages are as on January 1st 2016.

Rubbish must not be left on the field. Please collect droppings. All dogs to be kept on a lead.

No refunds for entries on the day.
