* Rules for Style and Performance

(Any breed or type or suitable size of pony or horse)

Mares, stallions or geldings, 4 years and over.

All sections to be judged 40% turnout of horse/pony and rider (total 40 marks), 60% for a freestyle show to be performed in an area approx. 20m x 40m and is to include the following movements: Halt, Walk on a Long Rein, Trot Serpentine, Lengthened Trot strides on Diagonal, Canter Figure of Eight (riders can complete an S shape, i.e. canter on each rein only once), Extended Canter on Diagonal (total 60 marks) = 100 max score.

Riders must not execute the required movements more than once. The individual show should be short and flowing.

Please note, dressage whips are not permitted and children are not allowed to wear spurs.

The tack and turnout of the horse/pony should be appropriate to the type of horse/pony being presented.

The rider should dress appropriately for the type of horse/pony being presented.

Dress code as per affiliated showing classes does not have to be strictly adhered to - the overall impression is of most importance.

JUDGES MUST OBSERVE THE FOLLOWING

Horses and Ponies who have qualified for or competed at HOYS (except SEIB Search for a Star and TSR HOYS Showing Master Class) in the years 2013, 2014 or 2015 are not eligible for the C&T Rider Showing Championships.

This Championship is aimed at keen and competitive amateurs and local professionals who are not competing horses or ponies at top level.

Stallions must be handled and ridden by people who have attained their 14th birthday on 1st January 2015

Passports must be available for inspection if asked for by a judge or official of the show

Qualification can pass down the line as far as 4th place. Entries close 1st September 2015.

Judges do not award Q cards or sign cards. Correct reporting of the full results of each class, indicating all CTR Members numbers must be passed onto CT Rider by the show secretaries within 14 days of the qualifying show. CT Rider will then award the qualifications as per our rules and inform the competitors. For late qualifying shows in September, show secretaries must send back the results to CTR the day after the show.

All riders who want to be eligible to qualify must be CT Rider Members. New memberships for the 2015 season are now on sale and can be purchased on line by visiting www.chilternrider.co.uk or by ringing our offices on 01582 748984

Memberships for the new season will have a prefix SH15

Many classes at the CTR Championships will be qualifiers for Equifest 2015. The Veteran classes are qualifiers for The Veteran Horse Society.

COMPETITORS PLEASE NOTE:

Please do not enter qualifying classes if your horse or pony is not eligible. You will get spotted. In 2006 AND 2007 we had to disqualify a horse and pony which is embarrassing and causes a lot of problems.

LEAD REINS ARE ONLY PERMITTED IN THE LEAD REIN CLASSES AND THE BEST TURNED OUT
